**Horse Camp – Terms and Conditions.**

## **Juddwood Farm, Nr Tonbridge, Kent, TN11 8AB**

**PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS CAMP IS ONLY OPEN TO ADULTS OVER THE AGE OF 18.**

### **DEFINITIONS:**

**Booking Fee:** shall mean the fee payable to Mrs J Bastable in respect of each Participant attending the Event

**Event:** shall mean the residential horse camp arranged by the Organiser will run from Thursday the 17<sup>th</sup> May – Sunday the 20<sup>th</sup> May 2012.

**Event Premises:** shall mean Juddwood Farm, Hayesden Lane, Tonbridge, Kent, TN11 8AB.

**Organiser:** shall mean Mrs J Bastable whose address is Juddwood Farm, Hayesden Lane, Tonbridge, Kent, TN11 8AB.

**Participant:** shall mean the adult attending the Event at the Event Premises.

### **1. Booking and Payment**

The Participant has agreed to pay a booking fee to the Organiser as follows:

- a. £50.00 non-refundable deposit to confirm the booking together with a signed booking form;
- b. £200.00 four (4) weeks prior to the Event, i.e. 20<sup>th</sup> April 2012

The total cost of £250.00 includes stabling, hay and straw for the horse (hard food is to be supplied by the Participant), full use of the facilities, instruction and lectures/demos plus three meals per day for the rider. You are more than welcome to arrive on Thursday evening after 6pm and dinner will be provided. Alcohol is not provided but you are very welcome to bring your own.

### **2. CANCELLATION.**

If the Participant wishes to cancel a booking then the balance of the booking fee received will be subject to cancellation charges as follows:

- a. Up to 28 days before 18<sup>th</sup> May 2012 – 50% of the Booking Fee
- b. 27 to 14 days before 18<sup>th</sup> May 2012 – 75% of the Booking Fee
- c. Less than 14 days before 18<sup>th</sup> May 2012 – 100% of the Booking Fee

In the event that horse or rider is unfit to participate prior to the start date of the event and a suitable veterinary or doctor certificate is received, the Organiser will refund all the booking fees received less an administration charge of £50.00

The Organiser reserves the right to cancel the Event at any time if in the absolute discretion of the Organiser the weather conditions may cause the terrain to become unsafe, if attendance at the Event is poor or the Organiser is no longer able to proceed with the Event due to an event outside the reasonable control of the Organiser.

If the Event is cancelled by the Organiser the maximum liability to the Participant shall be the price paid to the Organiser to attend the Event.

### **3. INSTRUCTIONS AND REGULATIONS**

The Participant must comply with all reasonable instructions given by the Organiser and must observe all the regulations issued by the Organiser for the Event.

If the Participant is in breach of these terms and conditions the Organiser shall be entitled, without incurring any liability to the Participant, to expel the Participant from the Event Premises.

### **4. EVENT PREMISES**

The participant is liable for any damage caused by them, or their guest or agent, to property belonging to the Organiser, the owners of the Event Premises or other Participants.

The Organiser reserves the right to refuse to admit or to expel from the Event Premises any person at any time.

The Participant must not do or permit within the Event Premises:

- a. Anything which shall be in any way a nuisance or which in the opinion of the Organiser is contrary to the character of the Event.
- b. Any entertainment or other activity for which a special licence is required;
- c. Anything that May involve a risk of injury to anyone present in the Event Premises.

## **5. HEALTH AND SAFETY**

The Participant must comply at all times during the Event with all fire, health and safety rules and regulations and any emergency procedures laid down by the Organiser.

Please note that there is no first aid cover supplied beyond that provided by the instructors taking the clinics and the provision of mobile phones by which an ambulance may be called if required.

Participants are responsible at all times during the Event for ensuring their horse is kept under control and does not represent a danger to anyone or any other horse present at the Event.

Participants must notify the Organiser of any issue relating to their horse that may be relevant to the health and safety within the Event. Participants must declare to the Organiser any behavioural traits of their horse that may need to be taken into account from a health and safety perspective.

The Organiser reserves the right to exclude any Participant or their horse if in the opinion of the Organiser there appears to be a risk of injury to the Participant or to other Participants or their horses.

Participants must strictly comply with the speed limit of 5mph for all vehicles within the Event Premises.

Except in an emergency, no vehicles parked within the Event Premises shall be moved between the hours of 20:00 and 08:00 unless agreed with the Organiser in advance.

Vehicles must at all times be parked within areas designated by the Organiser.

The Participant shall comply with any health and safety policy of the Organiser. There is a NO SMOKING policy. Recreational drugs of any kind will not be tolerated at Juddwood Farm at any time.

All accidents, injuries or illness must be reported as soon as possible to the Organiser.

NO DOGS allowed at the Event Premises.

All horses must be vaccinated against equine flu and tetanus and your horse's certificate must be supplied to the Organiser before the horse is unloaded at the Event.

All generators must be turned off between the hours of 23.00 and 06:30.

All riding hats used by Participants shall comply with current regulations and shall be worn fastened at all times when riding. Participants will not take part in any activity involving horse riding unless wearing suitable head protection.

Back/body protectors (Beta Level 3) must be worn for cross country and are recommended, but not compulsory for show jumping. By signing the booking form you agree to accept all the above risks and conditions.

## **6. INSURANCE**

Participants must ensure that all vehicles are covered by a valid third party insurance and shall on demand provide to the Organiser documentary evidence of such insurance. Participants who do not have evidence of vehicle insurance will not be permitted access to the Event.

Participants must bring with them documentary evidence of their public liability insurance relating to the use of their horse at the Event. Those Participants who are unable to provide such evidence will not be permitted to use, ride or exercise their horse within the Event Premises.



## **7. LIABILITY**

Participants bring property to the Event entirely at their own risk and neither the Organiser, or Juddwood Farm will accept any liability for any loss, howsoever caused, to property belonging to Participants or others.

Except in relation to personal injury or death caused by the negligence of the Organiser and / or Juddwood Farm all other liability for loss or damage howsoever caused is excluded to the fullest extent permitted by law.

No liability will be accepted by the Organiser for any loss sustained as a result of a breach of these Terms and Conditions by the Participant including, but not limited to, any request by the Organiser for the Participant to leave the Event Premises due to a breach of these Terms and Conditions or for any conduct liable to increase the risk of injury to anyone or damage to property.

## **8. FACILITIES**

Juddwood Farm is a block of 120 acres of grass and woodland.

There will be a camping area provided with plenty of room to park lorries, caravans or to pitch a tent. Hook up is not available.

There is a toilet and shower block.

There is a dining area/common room which along with meals being served, will also double up as a lecture room.

Internal stables are provided along with hay and straw for the horses.

There is one indoor arena, all the other arenas are on grass and full use will be made of Juddwood Farm's cross country course, which includes an inviting water complex.
